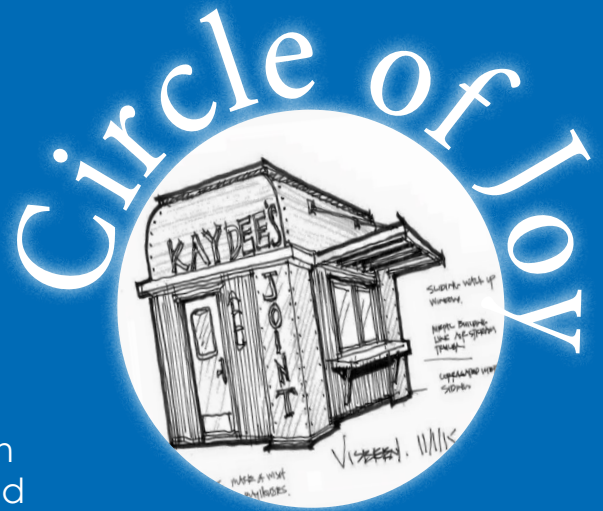


Kaydee, age 6, brain tumour
