Treatment for ALL involves chemotherapy and may include steroids, growth factors, radiotherapy and bone marrow transplant or a stem cell transplant. Esme got a big dose of sun and sand in February 2016 when she and her whole family were whisked off to Maui on a WestJet flight. The family learned that getting there is half the fun, receiving a gift basket mid-flight from the WestJet crew, and a tour of the flight deck upon arrival in the state of Hawaii.
