Rick Green is the former Mayor of the Township of Langley (2008-2011) and lifelong resident of British Columbia. Rick was the owner/operator of Super Valu in Tsawwassen before being elected Alderman for the City of Delta in 1987. In 1997 he moved to the Township of Langley to raise and breed horses, where he was elected Mayor in 2009. Rick has served on numerous regional committees including Translink Mayor's Council and the Metro Agriculture Committee for which he was Vice-Chair. During his tenure as Mayor, Rick successfully renewed the passenger rights to the interurban rail corridor and established and chaired the South of Fraser Community Rail Task Force. Rick has been a staunch advocate for all matters of political interest to the region through his popular blog, and is now retired in Aldergrove with his wife of over 52 years.
